Dear Jule:

At another meeting of the Ad-Hoc GARP Working Group of the Interagency Committee for the World Weather Program on October 23rd slightly revised alternatives to the previous proposal (Oct. 9th) were presented by the Working Group. The list of assumptions for what they now call Alternative 2B is attached. Principally this consists of a considerable scaling down of the Tropical Cloud Cluster Experiment, but leaving some flexibility for location. The assumptions given apply to the Eastern Pacific or the Atlantic Ocean. However, with equipment modification and increase in cost, the West Central Pacific (Marshall Islands) is another possible alternative.
